Objectives

The objectives of this training programme are to:

Methodology

This is an innovative leadership programme that has been proven all over the world to generate needed system shifts and cultural change. This leadership programme is a unique, whole-systems transformation, learning-in-action programme that grounds us in our deepest values and existing expertise. This training enables us to hold multiple perspectives and guides us to design for systems and cultural change.
